1. Fortuna Health Secures \$18M Series A Led by Andreessen Horowitz, with participation from Y Combinator to Streamline Medicaid Enrolment

The AI-powered platform simplifies Medicaid enrollment and recertification across 56 state programs, helping 25M+ beneficiaries maintain coverage. Integrated with major payers, it reduces coverage churn by 15% through multilingual interfaces and live support. Funding will expand state coverage and adapt to stricter federal requirements, including work verification rules affecting 11M enrollers. ([Link](#))

2. TriAgencis secures \$3M Series B-1 Led by Asclepius Ventures for Wisdom Tooth Prevention Tech

The company is developing a non-surgical device that prevents wisdom tooth formation in children through targeted warming of tooth buds. Funding will support FDA De Novo classification for the technology, which aims to eliminate 10M+ annual extractions in the U.S. The solution could transform dental care by addressing a \$3B+ market through prevention rather than treatment. 3. Everlab secures \$10M to Scale AI Preventive Care with Left Lane Capital Backing

The health tech startup combines advanced diagnostics like whole-body MRIs with AI analysis to detect chronic disease risks early, identifying life-threatening conditions in 2.5% of users. Funding will expand clinic networks and enhance AI tools for personalized prevention plans, targeting 20x growth this year while shifting healthcare from reactive to proactive care models. 4. Dash Bio Raises \$11M Led by The Aligned Fund to Transform Drug Development with Automated Bioanalysis

The company's automated lab platform accelerates drug development assays up to 10x faster than traditional methods, addressing a \$7-12B industry bottleneck. With \$17.5M total funding, it will expand GLP-compliant testing capabilities and clinical-stage adoption. Founded by ex-Moderna leadership, the solution combines automation with sample management software to meet biotech's speed and scalability demands. ([Link](#))

5. Charta Health Secures \$22M Series A Led by Bain Capital Ventures with SV Angel, South Park Commons, Madrona & Refract for AI Healthcare Billing

The AI-powered platform analyzes patient charts pre-submission to identify billing gaps and potential claim denials, integrating with existing EMR systems. Following an \$8.1M seed round,

the \$22M Series A will expand engineering teams and payer/provider integrations. Backed by Bain Capital Ventures and others, the solution reduces administrative burdens through real-time AI insights in healthcare revenue cycles. ([Link](#))

6. Medyria secures CHF 1.5M to Commercialize PyCath Cardiac Diagnostic Technology

The Swiss company will advance clinical studies and FDA submission for its cardiac diagnostic system—the only microcatheter measuring direct blood flow velocity for comprehensive heart assessments. Funding supports European expansion through a new Portuguese affiliate while addressing a critical gap in coronary diagnostics by evaluating microcirculation to expand treatment eligibility for angina patients. 7. Numan secures \$60M Series B Extension Led by Big Pi Ventures for Digital Men's Health Expansion

The digital men's health platform, which doubled revenue to \$90M, combines \$30M equity and \$27M debt financing to expand clinical services and international growth. Offering telehealth, prescriptions, and coaching, the company has achieved profitability amid rising demand for preventative care in obesity and hormonal health. Investors highlighted its scalable model in the digital health sector. ([Link](#))

8. KORTUC secures \$20M Series B Led by Midas Capital to Expand Radiosensitizer Cancer Trials

The biotech company is advancing a novel radiosensitizer through registrational trials for breast, cervical, and rectal cancers, targeting radiotherapy-resistant hypoxic tumors. With prior testing in 1,000+ Japanese patients, current Phase II trials expect controlled data by 2027. Funding will support global expansion of trials across five countries to improve radiation oncology outcomes. ([Link](#))

9. Blue Longevity Clinic secures €2M led by Eleven Ventures, with participation from Sofia Angels Ventures, to Bring AI-Powered Preventive Care to Southeast Europe

The longevity clinic will expand to Athens, Istanbul, and Sofia by September, offering AI-driven preventive care in a region with high out-of-pocket healthcare costs. Targeting the upper-middle class with science-backed protocols, the funding will grow medical teams and tech infrastructure. Investors see potential to establish Southeast Europe as a longevity tourism destination. ([Link](#))

10. Illimis Therapeutics raises \$42M Series B from DSC Investment, GS Ventures & Others for GAIA Platform

The biotech company will advance its bispecific fusion protein platform targeting TAM receptors to treat Alzheimer's and immune disorders. With \$42M in Series B funding from 16 investors, including major venture firms, it will expand its pipeline and pursue global pharma collaborations. The technology uniquely combines amyloid-targeting with immune modulation for CNS diseases. ([Link](#))

11. Eholo secures €250K Investment from Eoniq.fund to Enhance AI-Powered Psychology Platform

The psychology practice management platform, serving 10,000+ professionals in Spain, will enhance its AI tools including session transcription and payment processing. Funding will support compliance updates and planned 2026 U.S. expansion. The SaaS solution reduces administrative burdens for clinicians through scheduling, billing, and telehealth features while maintaining a patient-care focus. ([Link](#))

12. Truemedics secures \$20M from Peak XV in Series C, Reaching \$400M+ Valuation

The AI-powered health tech platform helps users find affordable generic medication alternatives through prescription uploads, while also selling personal care products. With \$64M in Series C funding, including Peak XV's investment, the company will scale operations. The platform has reached a \$400M+ valuation, backed by Accel, WestBridge, and other investors across previous rounds. ([Link](#))
