1. Greater Good Health Secures \$20.5M Series B from Allumia, DaVita, Flare, Optum, and Others for AI Primary Care

The company also secured a \$12.5 million debt facility from HSBC Innovation Banking. Greater Good Health leverages AI-powered tools for clinical synthesis and patient engagement to empower nurse practitioners, addressing the physician shortage while improving value-based outcomes for Medicare Advantage patients. 2. Yann LeCun's AMI Labs Raises \$1.03B from Unnamed Deep Tech and Robotics Funds to Build AI World Models

The startup's leadership includes CEO Alex LeBrun (founder of healthcare AI Nabla), signaling a heavy focus on applying predictive AI to physical systems like surgical robotics and medical automation. Unlike text-based LLMs, AMI's "world models" enable AI to reason and plan in physical environments, providing a foundational breakthrough for next-generation medical device autonomy. ([Link](#))

3. MindImmune Secures \$5M from Alzheimer's Drug Discovery Foundation and Lauder Family for AI Immune Therapy

MindImmune utilizes advanced biological modeling and precision medicine frameworks to target immune pathways that drive neurodegeneration. By shifting focus from amyloid plaques to immune system dysregulation, the company is innovating a new class of treatments. ([Link](#))

4. Science Corporation Closes \$230M Series C from Private Venture Investors to Commercialize AI PRIMA BCI

The PRIMA system uses a sub-retinal chip and AI-integrated glasses to restore functional vision to patients with advanced macular degeneration. By converting visual data into electrical signals, the technology has enabled blind patients to read again. The funding will support the 2026 European launch and FDA discussions, marking a massive milestone in neural engineering and vision restoration. ([Link](#))

5. SteerBio Launches with \$18.2M ARPA-H Federal Award to Pioneer AI-Programmable Lymphedema Therapy

This innovation involves injecting engineered human cells encased in hydrogel, which are then controlled by small-molecule regulators to produce repair proteins. This bio-digital approach offers a curative alternative to lifelong compression therapy for cancer survivors, representing a major breakthrough in synthetic biology and regenerative medicine for complex vascular conditions. 6. Grow Therapy Hits \$3B with \$150M Series D from TCV, Goldman Sachs, Sequoia, and Menlo for AI Mental Health

Grow Therapy utilizes AI-powered clinical support tools to assist therapists with documentation, note-taking, and patient progress tracking. By integrating these AI efficiencies with a vast insurance-backed network, the company has scaled to over \$1 billion in annual revenue. 7. Cognito Therapeutics Raises \$105M from Morningside, IAG, Starbloom, and Apollo for AI Neurotechnology

The funding supports its "Spectris" device, an AI-integrated, non-invasive neurostimulation platform for at-home Alzheimer's treatment. Spectris uses customized light and sound frequencies to stimulate gamma oscillations in the brain, aiming to preserve cognition and slow atrophy. ([Link](#))
